


What's happening in your neighborhood this month:

Preliminary site grading, benching, and access measures to facilitate hauling, import/export of materials, and placement of trailers and equipment on site is nearing completion. This work helps to ensure safe and stable working surfaces as the project progresses towards the excavation stage, and allows the team to safely and efficiently use the site footprint.

With excavation and shoring come an increased presence of heavy machinery on site. Several of the shoring operations will require brief pedestrian holds while the shoring piles are lifted overhead. Additionally, there will be increased presence of truck and trailer combinations entering/exiting site as material from the excavation is exported. These truck and trailer combinations will access the site using the recently-installed haul road that runs north to south along the western edge of the site.



Upcoming milestones for the month are given as follow:



Several small construction activities will take place beyond the boundaries of the site fence. All such activities will be coordinated in advance with the impacted parties by Mark Sweeters.
